



GUIDELINES FOR HIGHLANDS COUNTY 4-H

Rules

1. Contest is open to all 4-Hers ages 5 to 18 who are enrolled in the current year.
2. You must use the pots and caladium bulbs provided.
3. If your plant dies, you may not replace it with another caladium. You will need to notify the 4-H office that you will not be able to participate in the contest.
4. You must turn in your caladium log (this booklet). Please be sure to check whether you are a Cloverbud, Junior, Intermediate or Senior member on the top of the pages that are included for your pictures. You must submit a minimum of 4 pictures.
5. The caladium plants are due to the Fair Grounds (Building A) by Wednesday February 8, 2012 between the hours of 2:00pm and 6:00pm.

Judging

1. Each entry will be judged on its own merit, receiving a blue, red or white ribbon denoting excellent, good, or fair.
2. Entries are compared only after all initial judging to determine Best of Show.
3. All judge's decisions are final!
