Important Information

- Contestant Picture Day: 1/16 @3:30p in Robbin's Nursery. Contestants are to wear their Opening Number outfits provided by the MHC pageants, we will let you know what to provide. Photography by: Kimberly Gauger Photography
- Practice information: Each contestant must attend mandatory practices in order to compete- this helps keep the flow of pageant time as smooth as possible-, please dress comfy & appropriately for practices, **ALL PRACTICES ARE CLOSED TO ANYONE OUTSIDE OF THE PAGEANT CONTESTANTS & COMMITTEE**, Cell Phones have become a huge distraction at practices so contestants WILL be required to have their cell phones put away in a backpack or bag while at practice- no cell phones in back pockets, etc.
- Jr. Miss Dress Competition: Please keep dress, shoes and accessories AGE APPROPRIATE. Dress should be knee length-Think of holiday party style- NO Hi/Lo style. Must have a full back, No low cut front, No spaghetti straps/No strapless/No mid-riff baring. Dress heels should be no higher than 2 inches. Accessories: no long, fake eyelashes, no long dangling earrings. Nails, Make-up & hairstyle should be age appropriate to compliment the Dress.
- Contestant interviews will be the Saturday before pageant on 1/29 @2:00p in the Alan Jay Arena
Attire is age appropriate "Sunday Best"- no jeans, rompers, spaghetti straps/strapless
- Pageant Day: We will let you know asap what time to arrive at the fairgrounds.
BACKSTAGE WILL BE CLOSED. WE WILL HAVE VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE MEMBERS ASSISTING.
- At the end of the (not judged) opening number, contestants speak onstage, sharing a welcome & their name - This portion is judged.
- Promo Wear is next, the contestant will thank their sponsor
- At the end of the Judged Dress Competition, ALL contestants will be asked an onstage question that they know ahead of time. THEN special awards (Miss Congeniality & Most Photogenic) will be presented. After that recognition, the contestants will exit the stage.
- Once they return to the stage, the TOP 3 will each be announced. All remaining contestants will exit the stage. An onstage question that they DO NOT know ahead of time will be asked. After those questions are complete, the TOP 3 will exit the stage
- Once the TOP 3 are asked back onstage, our NEW Jr. Miss Highlands County will be announced along with her 1st & 2nd runners-up
